Summary:

In response to the interest and inquiry of Dr. DV Gokhale, the Institute of International Education (IIE) has established *The DV Gokhale International Grants in Statistics Program* through donations and a bequest from Dr. Gokhale. This unique and much-needed program will provide grants:

- to all undergraduate and graduate students to study statistics in the United States and India;
- to Indian undergraduate and graduate students to study statistics in the United States;
- to American undergraduate and graduate students to study statistics and related subjects in India; and
- to support faculty exchanges in this field between the United States and India.

Although students/faculty from India will be given preference, others may also qualify and are encouraged to apply.

Background:

Dr. DV Gokhale, Professor Emeritus of Statistics at the University of California at Riverside, received a Fulbright travel grant to study in the United States in the 1960s through IIE. This experience was one of the most important in his life, as it gave him the opportunity to study and make contacts in the United States. It eventually led to the move of Dr. Gokhale and his family to the United States, where they have been settled for the past 40 years. In appreciation of his experience and with the desire to give other students and faculty this same opportunity, Dr. Gokhale would like to establish a grants program focused on helping Indian students to study statistics in the United States, American students to study statistics and related subjects in India and to enable faculty members in this field to participate in exchanges between the two countries.

Program Details:

The *DV Gokhale Program* would reflect the following interests of the donor:

1. **Field of Interest:** Statistics.
2. **Institutions of Interest*:** University of Pune; University of California at Berkeley; University of California at Riverside; colleges and universities in California.
3. **Countries of Interest:** India; United States.
4. **Recipients of Interest:** undergraduate students; graduate students; faculty.

* If suitable candidates are not available within the Institutions of Interest, other candidates may also be considered.

REQUIRED:

- 1) **Current CV or résumé.** Include all academic degrees; degree-granting institutions and dates of degree award; and current and past employment with dates, places of employment, and positions held. CV or résumé must also include the following personal information:

 - Country of Citizenship
 - Gender
 - E-mail Address(es) & Telephone Number
 - Your current address
- 2) **A personal statement** of no more than 500 words describing how the funding will support your studies in statistics. Please provide a budget showing what the funds will be used for.*
- 3) **One (1) academic/professional letter of reference** from an academic and/or professional colleague who can speak to your aptitude in statistics, with his/her complete contact information.**
- 4) **An official transcript.**
- 5) **List of other grants and scholarships awarded.**
- 6) If you are entering a new institution, you must provide a **letter of acceptance.**
- 7) Please tell us how you learned about the DV Gokhale International Grants in Statistics Program.
