Overview, K01 Awards

- Stipulations
 - 75% of 12 month effort
 - 5 years
 - Possible to reduce effort in the last 2 yrs (e.g. to write R21/R01)

- Components
 - Specific Aims
 - Candidate Information and Goals for Career Development and Research Strategy
 - i.e. Research and Training
 - Letters of support/mentoring team
 - Training in the Responsible Conduct of Research

Loni & Tyler's awards

Tyler:

- NICHD
- Training in demography and population health
 - Training included (few) courses, research visits to data
- Research on Bayesian models for fertility rates in low resource settings
- Mentoring team: primary mentor from UW with team members from other US and international institutions

Loni & Tyler's awards

Loni:

- NHLBI
- Training in health policy, cardiovascular epidemiology
 - Training included (few) courses/workshops
- Research on frequentist and Bayesian approaches to spatial patterning in cardiovascular health disparities (blacks and whites)
 - Local
