- Funds research designed to help people make better informed healthcare decisions




Patient-Centered Outcomes Research Institute National Priorities for Health

 - Make a positive and significant impact on patient-centered care and health outcomes



Improving the Methods of Patient-Centered CER



 The goal of the Methods PFA is to fund methodological research projects that address critical methodological gaps that lead to improvements in the strength & quality of evidence generated by patient-centered CER studies.



As of April 2025, PCORI has awarded \$166 million to fund 170 Methods projects.

Methods PFA



- Projects must fall under at least one of the four programmatic priorities:
 - Methods to Improve Study Design
 - Methods to Support Data Research Networks
 - Methods to Improve Use of AI/ML
 - Methods Related to Ethical and Human Subjects Protection Issues in CER
- Offered 3 cycles/year, with up to \$750K in direct cost
- Max 3-year research period + 1 year for drafting the Final Research Report

Pre-Award



- Letter of Intent (LOI)
 - Reviewed for responsiveness
- Full Application
 - Reviewed for continued responsiveness, including to feedback given alongside LOI acceptance
- Online and Panel Merit Review
 - Provided by independent experts
- PCORI Information Request (PIR)
 - Comparable to NIH's JIT
- Award Notification
