Thank you for the strong support for the backbone of the US data infrastructure in FY23 Labor-HHS-Education appropriations. We are grateful for the FY23 levels for the Bureau of Labor Statistics, National Center for Education Statistics, and National Center for Health Statistics. We also appreciate the wise investments in the National Institutes of Health and the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality.

The \$15 million in additional funding for NCES, including \$10 million for the statistics line, will be put to immediate use to help families, schools, and administrators make better decisions.
